The administration of the Clifton Public Schools reviews and investigates all sworn statements filed within the district regarding the facts set forth in the sworn statements upon which the school relies to admit such students.

If the investigation completed by the Board of Education personnel discloses facts contrary to those set forth in this sworn statement submitted for admission, the Board of Education has the statutory right to bring suit before the Commissioner of Education to determine the validity of the affidavit, and in the event that any facts herein are found to be false, to recoup damages by requiring the payment of tuition for the length of time the student was enrolled.

All persons signing the sworn statements, and the parents of the student, would be joined in such a suit, and if the Commissioner rules in favor of the Board of Education, a judgment for the tuition will be granted, the Board of Education, in turn, will pursue payment.
