School 11 has partnered with NJ Positive Behavior Support in Schools (NJ PBSIS) to help us develop an intervention continuum to plan for preventing and, when necessary, intervening with social, behavior, and conduct issues.

Each school, through student and staff input, determines their 4 pillars that they will strive towards. School 11's pillars are: Respectful ATTENTIVE Responsible ENTHUSIASTIC It is not a curriculum - it is a framework for systems to identify needs, develop strategies, and evaluate practice toward success.

PBSIS is a tiered system of support, which is driven by data.

The framework of each tier is designed with a specific purpose and an aligned set of practices. When students are found following school wide expectations and displaying positive behaviors, they can eam
